- Three recommendations from professors or work supervisors using the reference form.
- A 500-word personal statement that addresses your personal and career goals and your interest in policy studies
- A current curriculum vitae or résumé.
- Students from countries in which English is not the native language must submit the results of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).
