



What to Bring on Move-In Day

Students are encouraged to speak with roommates prior to purchasing items that will be shared. TV, trashcans, cleaning supplies, and refrigerators are examples.

Personal Items:

- ✓ Extra-long twin sheets – see [Residence Hall Linens](#) information
- ✓ Pillow, egg crate cushion, comforter
- ✓ Toiletries, shower caddy, shower shoes
- ✓ Clothes hangers
- ✓ Cleaning supplies
- ✓ Clothing hamper or bag; HE detergent only

Utility Items

- ✓ Power strip - Woods or FireShield brand only
- ✓ Floor rug - 8x10 or less
- ✓ Small fan
- ✓ Small trash can, with trash bags
- ✓ Flashlight, with batteries
- ✓ Desk lamp – non-halogen
- ✓ Refrigerator – 3.1cf or less
- ✓ Water-boiling pitchers, Keurig – must have enclosed heating elements
- ✓ Plug-ins or reed diffusers
- ✓ Incandescent, CFL, or LED lighting

Organization and Office

- ✓ Calendar and alarm clock if not on phone
- ✓ Clear plastic containers for food
- ✓ Printer paper
- ✓ 3M Command products for hanging items and décor
- ✓ Posters, pictures
- ✓ Small *standing* shelves, seating
- ✓ Small live plants
- ✓ Curtains

Animals

- ✓ Small aquatic animals
- ✓ Maximum of 10 gallons per room
- ✓ Maximum of 2 tanks per room
- ✓ Animals must be fully aquatic

As recommended by current DelVal students, pack lightly for your initial move-in day. You may not need all that you think you need.
