

Daily Symptom Monitoring with Medicat

To support the health and safety of the University community, daily symptom monitoring via Medicat is required to assist in preventing the spread of COVID-19.

Medicat uses your DelVal username and password to login. Here is the link to Medicat:

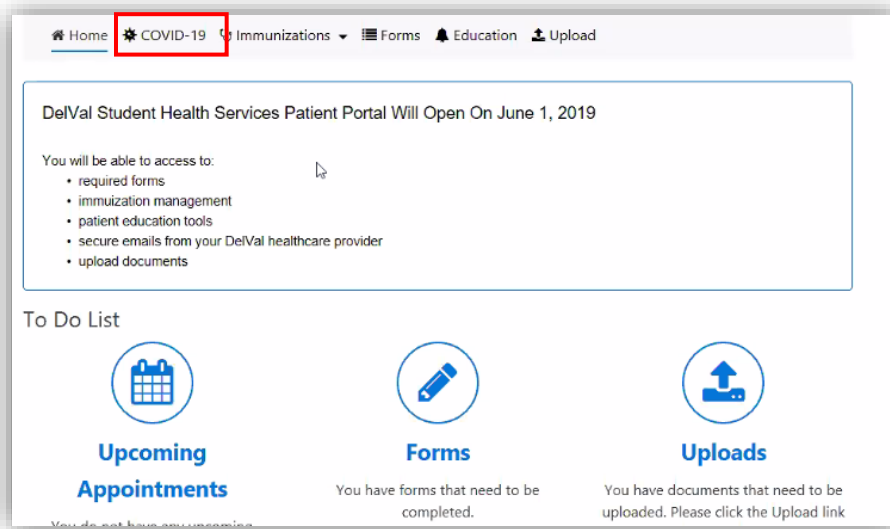

- Select Delaware Valley University
- Select 'Remember selection for this web browser session' for an easier login next time.
- It is recommend you save this link as a favorite or bookmark to make it easier to complete the daily symptom self-screening.

Each morning perform a COVID-19 self-screening via Medicat and assess your body temperature using a thermometer.

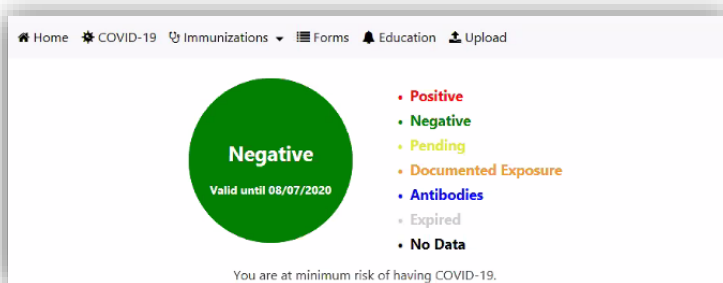
Students, faculty, and staff will receive a daily email reminder to complete their Medicat screening. You may also opt in for text message reminders.

Once logged into the Medicat System you will select the COVID-19 tab.



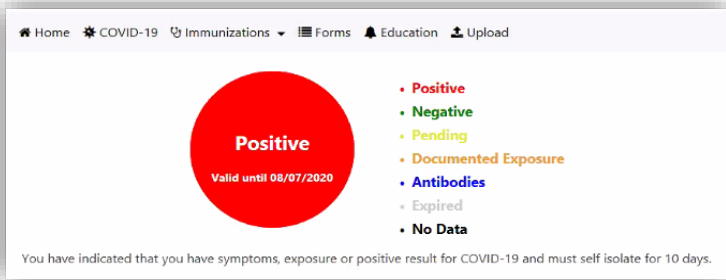
Once in the COVID-19 section of Medicat you will be asked to answer a series of questions. The questions will guide you through each part of the symptom self-screening.

When you complete the self-screening in Medicat one of four notices will display.

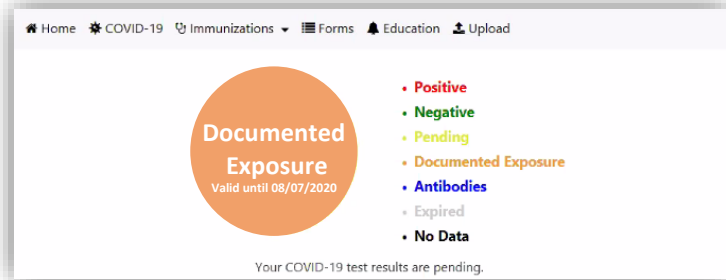


Green: All clear to come to campus

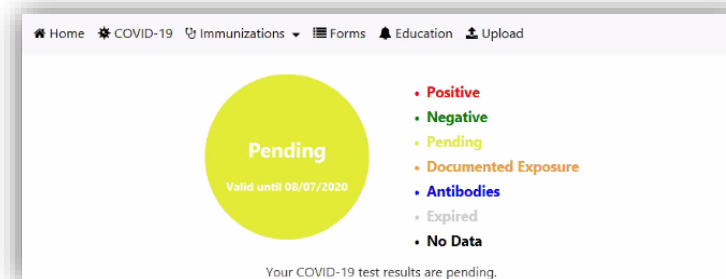
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Red: Do not come to campus, isolate, seek medical evaluation



Documented exposure, self-quarantine, seek medical guidance



Contact health care provider, lab results pending, traveled to hot spot

Students, Staff, and Faculty should be prepared to show their daily Green/Negative notice. This may be requested at any time while on campus, or when entering a classroom, or when entering an office.

Remember, if symptomatic, temperature 100.4 F or over, or potential exposure to COVID-19:

- **Stay home! Begin self-quarantine/self-isolation and:**
 - Students Normal Hours M-F (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.): Call Health Center at 215-489-2252
 - Students After Hours (after 4:30 p.m.): Call Public Safety at 215-489-4444
 - Employees: Alert your supervisor and primary care physician
