

## Types of Accommodations

### ⇒ **Disability Accommodations**

Disabilities are determined by appropriate professional evaluation and legally defined by the ADA and the Rehabilitation Act. Reasonable accommodations are supported only for students with documented disabilities.

### ⇒ **COVID-19 Accommodations**

COVID-19 accommodations are for students who reside with individuals who are at increased risk according to the CDC guidelines. Documentation from appropriate professional is required.

## How Accommodations will be Communicated

### ⇒ **Disability Accommodations**

Student disability accommodations will be emailed to both instructors and students. Instructors and students will be asked to reply to email and include typed name or electronic signature.

### ⇒ **COVID-19 Accommodations**

Student COVID-19 accommodations will be emailed to both instructors and students. Instructors and students will be asked to reply to email and include typed name or electronic signature.

## Exams and Testing

### ⇒ **Spring 2021**

In order to be in compliance with the CDC, state, and local guidelines for COVID-19, the revised Learning Support Services exam and testing accommodations will remain in place. To ensure six feet of distance is maintained, to reduce the number of times individuals would have to come in contact with others, and to minimize the number of times paper is exchanged between individuals, testing will be conducted in the same manner as it was during the fall 2020 semester with faculty administering tests and exams online/electronically.
