

GREEN and GOLD DAY VISITOR GUIDELINES

We're excited to welcome you to DelVal—in person—to see for yourself what life is like on campus. To ensure the health and safety of the Delaware Valley University community and our visitors, we have put in place the following measures based on public health directives from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and CDC:

BEFORE YOUR VISIT

To limit the number of guests at our event, we are asking for students to **only bring one visitor with them, if possible**. You are required to pre-register for this event so we can easily track and allow for social distancing. Unfortunately, we cannot allow walk-ins and if you are not pre-registered, you will be turned away.

FACE COVERINGS & HYGIENE

You and your guest are **required to wear a face covering** for the duration of your visit to DelVal. Face coverings should cover both your nose and mouth, including masks without an exhalation valve and face shields. Face coverings should be worn at all times, especially when physical distancing of six feet or greater is not possible.

Our public restrooms will be available for use. We strongly encourage abiding by public health guidelines, including washing your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, or using hand sanitizer.

Bottled water will be available during your visit and some prepackaged snacks for you to take home after the event will also be provided. And while we eagerly anticipate meeting you in person, our staff will not be shaking hands out of an abundance of caution—please don't be offended.

CHECK FOR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

We ask you to perform a COVID-19 symptom assessment using [Apple's Covid Screening Tool](#) before arriving on campus. Each person attending will need to show us the results of their screening. You will need to share your results at the end of the screening and obtain a response that indicates, **NO TESTING IS REQUIRED AT THIS TIME**. Please refrain from visiting if you are not feeling well.

ON THE DAY OF YOUR VISIT

On the day of your visit, check in will take place in your car. In order to speed this process up, please have the results of your online Covid Screening ready for us to view and be prepared to have your temperature taken. Please arrive no earlier than 30 minutes before the start of your first session. It is very important that you follow the schedule according to the major for which you were admitted to DelVal. We have done a lot of preparation to ensure that sessions are following social distancing protocols in order to protect you and our campus community, but it won't be possible if you don't adhere to the schedule provided to you. We kindly ask that you exit campus at the conclusion of your scheduled sessions.

Tour groups will be limited to **three families per tour guide and tours will be shortened (30 minutes)**. For the safety of our campus community, residence halls will not be shown on tours and we are limiting the number of interior buildings that tour groups will enter. Some of the areas that will not be available include: small animal science labs and the greenhouses.

We will be providing an academic session, tour of campus and time for you to participate in our fair on the Quad. When in sessions, chairs will be placed socially distanced from other families. You will have an opportunity to speak with a professor, but we will limit the number of people at a time and ask that you please remain socially distant, if there is a wait to speak with faculty.

Please be reminded that you are undertaking your visit at your own risk. While Delaware Valley University is taking all precautions to safeguard our community, we cannot eliminate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection on campus. Please note all employees at the Green and Gold Day event will have completed the University's Daily Covid-Screener.
