
There is No Processional for Students

## **GRADUATION MAP**




## Seating Arrangements

#### At The End of The Ceremony:

- → When It is Announced to the Graduates,
  Depart the Field and Go To Your
  Vehicle to Leave Campus

#### **ACADEMIC HOOD & REGALIA**

The Academic Hood is just that, a Hood.

Hold it so that it may be placed over your head with the colors to the back. Once it is on, have someone assist you to fold out the colors so they show.

At Graduations, Marshalls will circulate to provide final assistance.

#### **REMINDERS:**

- Please be advised that high heels (stiletto/spike) are not allowed on the field.
- You will be walking and standing as well as climbing stairs, so it is recommended that you wear a comfortable shoe (flats, boots, sneaker, or a low wedge heel).

#### **IMPACT OF SEVERE WEATHER:**

- Guests are encouraged to check the weather on the days leading up to Commencement and to prepare for heat or rain.
- We suggest guests dress in layers and bring appropriate outdoor accessories, such as sunscreen and umbrellas.
  - Sunscreen and umbrellas will be provided for graduates
- Bottled water will be available for graduates and guests.
- Severe weather is defined as conditions that make holding an outdoor ceremony dangerous or impossible.
- Should there be severe weather on the weekend of the ceremonies adjustments to the ceremonies may occur. The University will make announcements about severe weatherrelated changes to the Commencement ceremony via this webpage, email and social media.
