About Delaware Valley University

Delaware Valley University was founded as the National Farm School by Rabbi Dr. Joseph Krauskopf in 1896 to provide education for immigrants. Dr. Krauskopf believed passionately that the answer to the growing urban poverty he saw in Philadelphia and across this country was farming. He founded the school to provide a quality education that included the science of farming and animal husbandry in the classroom, followed by practical experience in the field. This concept, now known as experiential education, has grown to become the award-winning Experience360 Program at DelVal.

1,000 Acres of Living Laboratories

Delaware Valley University is comprised of over 1,000 acres of land, including a Dairy Center, Swine Science Center, greenhouse complex, Equine Center, Gemmill Animal Science Complex, Roth Center for Sustainable Agriculture, apiary and additional facilities over three locations (main campus, Gemmill and Roth properties). Agriculture students work in our laboratories, greenhouses, and fields. Those interested in animal science work directly with animals from year one of their studies in our laboratories, animal facilities, and open land both on and off campus.

Business and humanities students gain experience in our counseling psychology lab, Small Business and Entrepreneurship Center, media lab and other hands-on facilities to prepare them for their careers or graduate school.

DelVal is one of the few universities in the country to require a hands-on learning component embedded into every curriculum. Our students benefit from both superb in-class instruction and direct, firsthand experience from day one. DelVal students establish measurable learning objectives for their experiential learning activities and reflect on their progress and goals throughout the experiences. 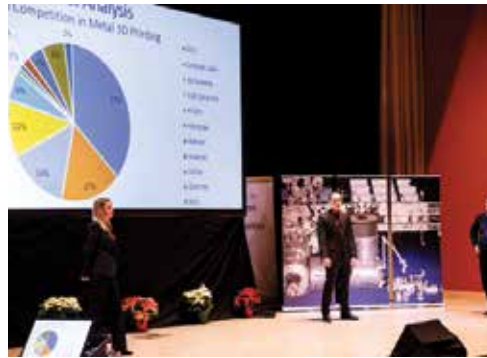


Academic Programs
