



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Welcome to our Kids U! and Inspire U! weeklong, full-day, specialty, next-level, fun, and adventure filled summer camps and programs. All on-site summer camps and programs are full day, 9:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. on our Doylestown campus. We are bursting with excitement to roll out our 2023 season. As we prepare for camp and program arrivals, please note the following:

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

Each day, parents/guardians should arrive between 8:30-8:45 a.m., park in [Admission Lot C](#) (#22 on map) and walk your child/teen into the [Life Sciences Building](#) (#24 on map) where you will be greeted by Kids U! and Inspire U! staff. **Do not leave your child/teen unattended or leave until they are checked-in with their camp assistant.** *Staff will not be in place before 8:30 a.m. If you arrive early, please wait with your child.*

*If your child/teen is participating in **Junior Equestrian Riding Camp or Exploring Equine Management**, participants should arrive between 8:30-8:45 a.m. and report directly to the [Equestrian Center](#) (#39 on map). Parents/Guardians should arrive in front of the Equestrian Center by 3 p.m. for dismissal.*

Pick up is at 3 p.m. also at the Life Sciences Building. Park in the same lot and walk in to pick up your child. **Parents/guardians must show identification and sign a dismissal sheet.** If someone other than you is picking up your child, please include their name on the camper form or complete a [Pick-Up Authorization Form](#) to add this person. **This person must present ID.**

EACH DAY, ALL CAMPERS NEED TO BRING:

- A non-perishable or cold-packed lunch, drinks, water-bottle and two snacks each day.
- A light sweatshirt or jacket is recommended since air-conditioned classrooms can be chilly.
- A poncho or an umbrella for rainy days. Sunscreen for sunny days. Many activities are on our outdoor campus, and all groups walk back and forth across campus to their classrooms, labs, and outdoor campus- rain or shine.

Extended Care Caesar's Clubhouse Early Care Club operates from 7:00-9:00 a.m. and Caesar's Clubhouse After Care operates from 3:00-6:00 p.m.

If your child/teen is enrolled in **Extended Early or Late Care**, park in [Admission Lot C](#) (#22 on map) and walk your child/teen into the [Life Sciences Building](#) (#24 on map) where you will be greeted by Kids U! and Inspire U! staff. **Do not leave your child/teen unattended or leave until they are checked-in with their camp assistant. Parents/guardians must show identification and sign a dismissal sheet.** If someone other than you is picking up your child, please include their name on the camper form or complete a [Pick-Up Authorization Form](#) to add this person. **This person must present ID.**

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Camper Behavior Contract

Kids U!/Inspire U! staff and management's priority is to ensure a safe and fun learning environment for all campers, staff, and families. This mission directly relates to the University's core values and its commitment to creating an environment that affirms respect for self and others, and that seeks excellence, accountability, and integrity in all things.

Please read this Behavior Contract with your camper and ensure that your camper understands our camp's behavior policies.

Expectations

- Be respectful of everyone and all property
- Always stay with the group
- Keep your hands, feet, and other objects and belongings to yourself
- Pay attention and listen when others are speaking
- Use appropriate language
- Ask for help when needed

Consequences/Remediations

Failure to follow these expectations will result in an unsafe or unenjoyable atmosphere for your camper and others in the camp. Should that happen, the following consequences/remediations may occur: Consequences/remediations depending on the severity of the situation or if the behavior persists, one or more of the following consequences/remediations will be taken.

1. Camp Directors will discuss behavior with the camper.
2. Camp Directors will discuss the behavior with the parent/guardian.
3. The child will be sent home immediately for the day.
4. In extreme cases child will be sent home and not allowed to return to camp.

NOTE: There are no refunds when a child's behavior requires he/she be sent home
