



SUMMER 2025 IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Welcome to our Kids U! and Inspire U! weeklong, specialty, next-level, fun, and adventure filled summer camps and programs. We are bursting with excitement for our 2025 season. As we prepare for camp and program arrivals, please note the following:

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

- All on-site summer camps and programs are full day 9:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. on our Doylestown campus.
- **Each day, parents/guardians should arrive between 8:30-8:45 a.m.**
- Park in [Admission Lot C](#) (#22 on map) and walk your child/teen into [Life Sciences Building](#) (#24 on map) where you will be greeted by Kids U! and Inspire U! staff. **Do not leave your child/teen unattended or leave until they are checked-in with their camp/program assistant. Staff will not be available before 8:30 a.m. If you arrive early, please wait with your child.**
- *If your child/teen is participating in **Junior Equestrian Riding Camp**, please arrive between 8:30-8:45 a.m. and report directly to the [Equestrian Center](#) (#39 on map). Parents/Guardians should arrive in front of the Equestrian Center by 3 p.m. for dismissal.*
- **Pick up is at 3:00 p.m. also at Life Sciences Building.**
- Park in [Admission Lot C](#) (#22 on map) and walk in to pick up your child/teen into [Life Sciences Building](#) (#24 on map) where you will be greeted by Kids U! and Inspire U! staff.
- **Parents/guardians must show identification and sign a dismissal sheet.** If someone other than you is picking up your child, please include their name on the camper form. **This person must be on the camper/teen form and present an ID.**

EACH DAY, ALL CAMPERS AND TEENS NEED TO BRING:

- A non-perishable or cold-packed lunch, drinks, water bottle, and two snacks each day.
- A light sweatshirt or jacket is recommended since air-conditioned classrooms can be chilly.
- A poncho, hoodie, or an umbrella for rainy days. Sunscreen for sunny days. Many camp activities are on our outdoor campus, and all groups walk back and forth across campus to their classrooms, labs, and outdoor campus- rain or shine.

FORMS

To provide a positive and safe experience, every family must complete a participant form for each participant enrolled in a Kids U! camp or Inspire U! teen program.

- ⇒ **REQUIRED Camper/Teen Form:** Required for all camp and program participants.
- ⇒ **REQUIRED Riding Form:** Required for all equine riding participants.

- ⇒ If your child/teen will be taking part in equestrian riding camp, you must complete **both** the Summer Camps and Teen Program Form **AND** the Riding Form.

EXTENDED CARE

Caesar's Clubhouse Early Care Club operates from 7:00-9:00 a.m. and Caesar's Clubhouse After Care operates from 3:00-6:00 p.m.

- If you need early or after care, you must register for [EXTENDED CARE](#)
- If your child is enrolled in **Extended Early or Late Care**, park in [Admission Lot C](#) (#22 on map) and walk your child/teen into [Life Sciences Building](#) (#24 on map) where you will be greeted by Kids U! and Inspire U! staff.
- **Parents/guardians must show identification and sign a dismissal sheet.** If someone other than you is picking up your child, please include their name on the camper form. **This person must present a photo ID.**
