## **Diamond Award**

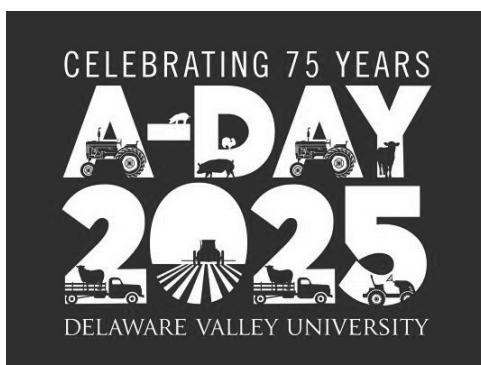

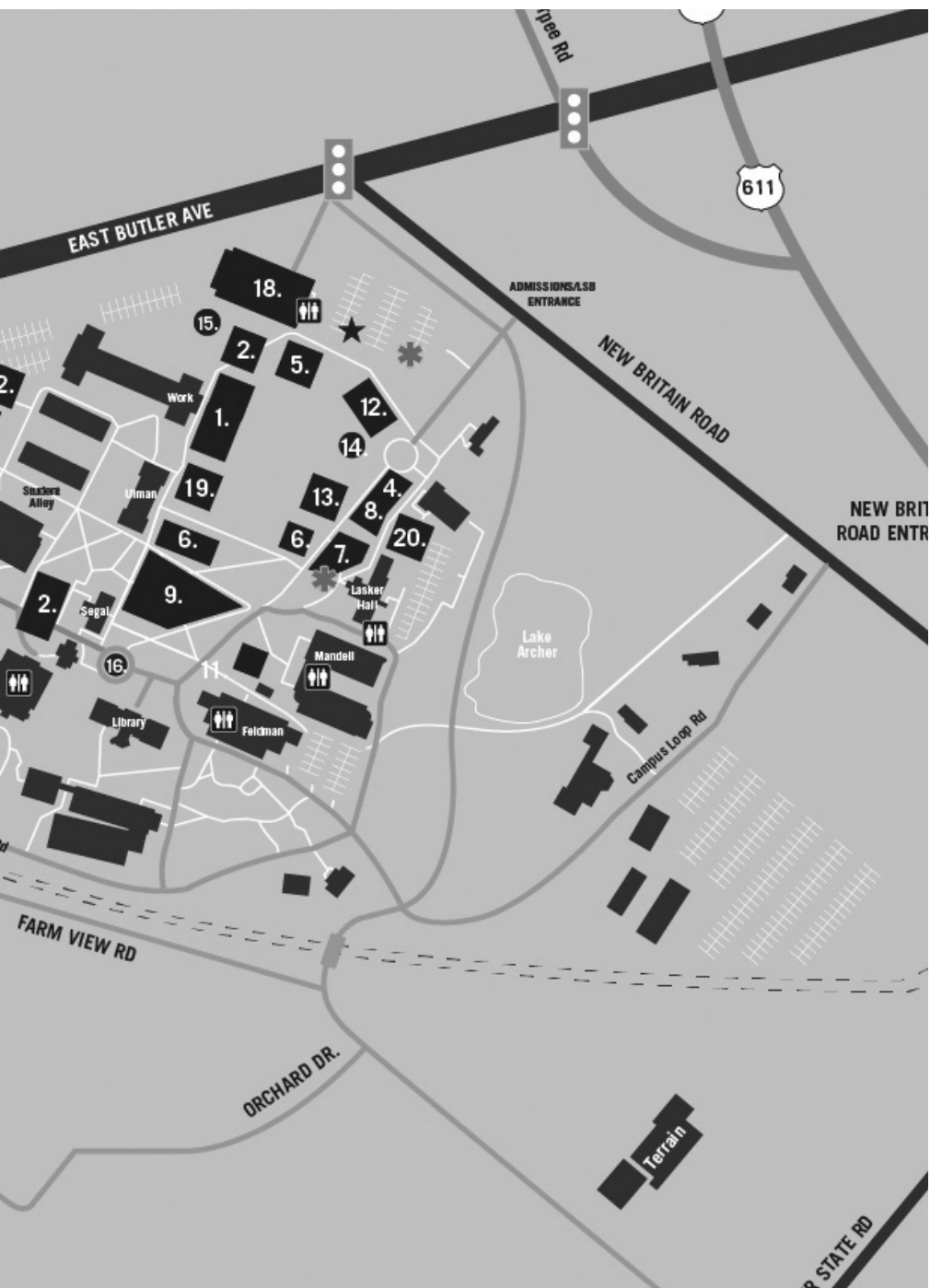
