


The DelVal Alumni Summer Newsletter


The mission of Caesar's Cupboard is to provide necessary personal care items and basic non-perishable food options

On Sunday, May 18, 411 students earned their Bachelor of Arts (BA) or Bachelor of Science (BS) degree from DelVal. These students completed 21,426 classes during their time at DelVal en route to graduating. Here are a few other interesting facts about the BA/BS graduates of the Class of 2025!

Total credits taken at DelVal	48,215.5 credits taken at DelVal
Total number of classes taken at DelVal	21,426 classes taken at DelVal
% of students that graduated in a different major than they applied to DelVal for	43.6% changed majors (179/411)
% club or organization	63.9% joined a club or organization(263/411)
% played a sport	38.2% played a sport (157/411)
% athlete or club/organization	81.0% were a student athlete and/or joined a club or organization (333/411)
% entered as transfer students	29.7% entered as transfer students (122/411)
